Students will also engage in a multitude of physical science observations as they view the impressive geologic terrain by day and the brilliant star-studded sky by night.

During our stay, we will visit the San Bernardino National Forest Service Center, the Idyllwild County Park Nature Center, San Jacinto State Park and Native American pictographs. We will also hike the Idlylwild Nature Trail with its stunning panoramic views and the scenic Ernie Maxwell Trail with the monolith of Taquitz (Lily) Rock in our sights.
