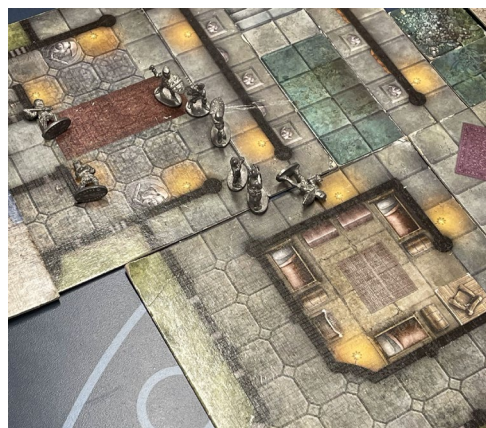

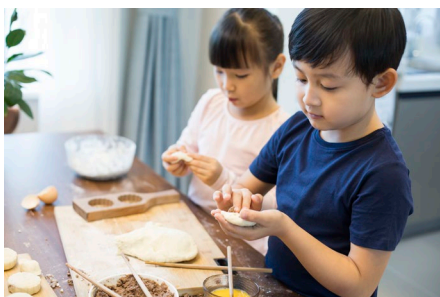

Payment Policy: One week’s tuition is due at time of enrollment. The deposit is applied to the final week of camp. Weekly camp fees are due every Monday. A \$25 late fee is charged if payment is not received by 12 pm Tuesday.

Cancellation Policy: If you enroll in camp and your plans change, or you have concerns about your child attending camp this summer, you can receive a full refund/credit for camp tuition, less registration fee. **Program change request must be received 2 weeks prior to enrolled camp week start date.** Participants who do not attend their registered camp week, or who do not contact us to cancel two weeks prior to start date, will not receive a refund or credit. By submitting your payment, you are agreeing to the policy outlined above.



2025 Camp Policies

Forms, Immunization Records and Insurance Cards

After online registration, parents will be emailed additional forms to complete via DocuSign. Students will not be permitted to attend The Rhoades School without a completed registration form, summer camp waiver, immunization records and insurance card. Please email Erika Magner, Summer Camp Coordinator, at emagner@rhadesschool.com if you have any questions regarding required forms.

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Student Personal Electronic Devices & Cell Phones

If a student brings a cell phone or smart device (including smart watch) to school, the device must be turned off and in the student's backpack. Cell phones and smart watches are not permitted to be used during the school day. If these devices are out and/or in use without permission, they will be confiscated. Lunch & Snacks

Campers should bring a lunch and two snacks (morning and afternoon). We cannot reheat or refrigerate any lunches. No glass water bottles or containers.

Sunscreen

Apply sunscreen to your child prior to coming to camp and provide a hat they may wear during outside play time (please label the hat with your child's name).

Medication

All prescription medications and over-the-counter products must be accompanied by written physician's instructions and must be in the original container with the child's name and appropriate information noted. In addition, parents are required to fill out a [medication authorization form](#) to allow school personnel to administer medication.

Allergy, Asthma and/or Diabetes Action Plan

If your child has a food allergy, asthma and/or diabetes, please make sure to work with camp staff to have an action plan in place prior to the beginning of camp. Action plans must be completed by a physician and submitted to Erika Magner, Summer Camp Coordinator, at emagner@rhadesschool.com as soon as possible. Your camper will not be able to attend camp until we receive an action plan. Please contact Erika Magner for questions regarding action plans.
