

## Parental Consent - Voluntary Return to Campus

<< SCHOOL BRAND >> ("School") and the parents and/or legal guardians listed above ("Parents") understand and agree that it is the voluntary decision of Parents to permit their child to resume on-site programs at the << SCHOOL CAMPUS >>. While the School will implement safety protocols and training in accordance with relevant regulations to mitigate the risk of the spread of COVID-19, **the decision to re-open physical classrooms does not mean that there is no risk of transmission. There is still much to learn about coronavirus, especially its effects on children, and there is no such thing as zero risk.** However, the School is taking measures to mitigate the chances of the spread at our School. Parents are also responsible for mitigating the risks that their child may present to their own health or the health of others at the School. Parents should thoughtfully consider the risks and other factors that may affect their child and family, and may wish to address these their concerns with their pediatrician or other health care provider. Parents hereby agree and consent as follows:

1. Monitoring at Home: Parents agree to monitor their child's health each day and keep their child home if he or she has a fever of 100.4 degrees or above, cough, fatigue, and/or other physical symptoms that require observation, health isolation, or medical treatment.
2. Temperature Taking: Parents understand that the School will take their child's temperature before entering the School building and, as needed, throughout the day. If a child has a fever of 100.4 or above or shows other symptoms of illness, he or she will be isolated, Parents will be contacted, and the child must be picked up within one hour. If a child is sent home, he or she cannot return to school until he or she is symptom-free and fever-free without medication for 72 hours.
3. COVID-19 Safety Procedures and Protocols: Parents consent to the safety measures taken by the School in accordance with relevant regulations to reduce the spread of COVID-19, and agree to comply with any safety directives issued by the School, including not attending School for a period of time due to risk of exposure.
4. No Zero-Risk: Parents understand that these are safety measures and not a guarantee that anyone will be prevented from contracting any illness.
5. Tuition: Parents understand and agree that as long as the School is providing educational instruction for students, the tuition obligation remains unconditional whether or not their child is able to attend due to the child's health or any directives issued in response to potential exposure in accordance with Paragraph 3 above. If it is necessary to temporarily close the School due to orders from the federal, state, or local government, the School will offer distance learning and tuition will continue at standard rates.
6. Accommodations: If Parents desire a reasonable accommodation for their child to participate in the school programs with the safety protocols in place, Parents will make such a request in writing to the School administration and cooperate in the interactive process as set forth in the School's ADA Policy.

*Parents certify they have read and understand this consent, the Parent-Student Handbook, and any other COVID-19 communications from the School ("COVID-19 Policies") and agree to comply with any and all COVID-19 Policies.*

*Parents understand and acknowledge that certain risk are inherent to COVID-19 and voluntarily assume such risks, whether described above, known or unknown, and inherent or otherwise, and take full responsibility for any injury or loss their family may suffer arising in whole or in part from COVID-19 and their child's on-site programs.*

*Further, Parents voluntarily waive and release any claim of liability against the School, its affiliates, officers, directors, employees, representatives, successors, and assigns (collectively the "Released Parties"), and expressly agreed to hold harmless the Released Parties, from any claims related to COVID-19 in connection with their child's attendance of on-site programs, to the fullest extent permitted by law.*
