
Before & After School Programs

Extended Day • Athletics & Enrichment



General Information

The Rhoades School offers both before and after-school care in our Extended Day and Athletics & Enrichment Programs. Students on campus after dismissal must be enrolled in Extended Day or other prescheduled activities such as athletics, enrichment classes or private music lessons.

Our Before & After School Programs offer students enriching opportunities for discovery and exploration before and after the normal school day hours. These programs provide numerous options for fun while also reinforcing the essential lessons and values taught throughout the school day.

Registration for Extended Day, Enrichment Classes, Private Music Lessons & Athletics:

- Deadline for enrolling students for Extended Day, enrichment classes & private music lessons is
 Wednesday, March 20.
- Students who are currently enrolled in Extended Day do not need to submit a new form.
- All outstanding invoices must be paid in full before the student may register for any Before or After-School Programs.
- All students must have a completed registration form on file accompanied by full payment in the office before participation in Extended Day, enrichment classes, private music lessons or athletics.
- Enrichment classes, private music lessons & athletics are filled on a "first come, first served basis." It is advisable to register as soon as possible to avoid disappointment.
- Payment can be made via check (payable to The Rhoades School) or credit card (fee applies).

- Classes that do not meet the minimum enrollment requirement will be cancelled and participants will be notified as soon as possible.
- Enrichment classes are not prorated for late registration.
- · All fees are nonrefundable.
- Athletics & Enrichment classes do not meet during school closure days or half-days.
- There is no provision for make-up classes if a participant is absent for any reason or if the school is closed due to an emergency.
- Parents must notify the music instructor within 24 hours if a student will miss a lesson. If the
 instructor is not notified within 24 hours, instructors are not required to make up the missed
 lesson.
- Parents are responsible for scheduling a music make-up lesson if a field trip/event conflicts with the music lesson within 24 hours of the anticipated lesson conflict.

Extended Day

Our program allows families the flexibility to drop-off before the school day starts and pick-up after the normal dismissal time. Our program is organized to support emotional, physical and cognitive wellness, provide your child with opportunities to learn valuable life skills, and to reinforce the skills they're learning during the school day.

Monart: Drawing From Science

Examples: Life cycles of animals or plants, the solar system, insects, dinosaurs, etc.

Whether we draw a gigantic brontosaurus or a butterfly emerging from a cocoon, the exploration of science will be artistic, informative and fun.
