# **General Information**

The Rhoades School offers both before and after-school care in our Extended Day and Athletics & Enrichment Programs. Students on campus after dismissal must be enrolled in Extended Day or other prescheduled activities such as athletics, enrichment classes or private music lessons.

Our Before & After School Programs offer students enriching opportunities for discovery and exploration before and after the normal school day hours. These programs provide numerous options for fun while also reinforcing the essential lessons and values taught throughout the school day.

### Registration for Extended Day, Enrichment Classes, Private Music Lessons & Athletics:

- Deadline for enrolling students for Extended Day, enrichment classes & private music lessons is Monday, March 17.
- All outstanding invoices must be paid in full before the student may register for any Before or After-School programs.
- All students must have a completed registration form on file accompanied by full payment in the office before participation in Extended Day, enrichment classes, private music lessons or athletics.
- Enrichment classes, private music lessons & athletics are filled on a "first come, first served basis." It is advisable to register as soon as possible to avoid disappointment.
- Payment can be made via check (payable to The Rhoades School) or credit card (fee applies).
- For credit card payments, please upload your <u>financial information in Alma</u> and contact Danene Schott, Business & Finance Manager at (760) 436-1102, ext. 303 or email <u>DSchott@rhoadesschool.com</u>.
- Athletics, Enrichment classes & Private Music lessons do not meet during school closure days, early dismissal days or Parent Conferences.
- All fees are nonrefundable.
- Extended Day:
  - If your student is currently enrolled in Extended Day, a new registration form is not required to keep your schedule. If you would like to modify your schedule, a new registration form is required.
  - Late fees for Extended Day pick up after 5:30 p.m. is \$15 for each 15-minute increment.
  - The emergency drop-in rate for Extended Day is \$40 per day and includes both before and after-school care.
- Athletics & Enrichment Classes:
  - There is no provision for make-up classes/practices if a participant is absent for any reason or if the school is closed due to an emergency.
  - Athletics & Enrichment classes that do not meet the minimum enrollment requirement will be cancelled and participants will be notified as soon as possible.
  - Athletics & Enrichment classes are not prorated for late registration and are non-refundable.
- Private Music Lessons:
  - There is no provision for make-up lessons if a participant is absent for any reason or if the school is closed due to an emergency.
  - Parents must notify the music instructor within 24 hours if a student will miss a lesson. If the instructor is not notified within 24 hours, instructors are not required to make up the missed lesson.
  - Parents are responsible for scheduling a music make-up lesson if a field trip/event conflicts with the music lesson within 24 hours of the anticipated lesson conflict.

# **Extended Day**

Our program allows families the flexibility to drop-off before the school day starts and pick-up after the normal dismissal time. Our program is organized to support emotional, physical and cognitive wellness, provide your child with opportunities to learn valuable life skills, and to reinforce the skills they're learning during the school day.


## Keys & Strings Music Club
