General Information

The Rhoades School offers both before and after-school care in our Extended Day and Athletics & Enrichment Programs. Students on campus after dismissal must be enrolled in Extended Day or other prescheduled activities such as athletics, enrichment classes or private music lessons.

Our Before & After School Programs offer students enriching opportunities for discovery and exploration before and after the normal school day hours. These programs provide numerous options for fun while also reinforcing the essential lessons and values taught throughout the school day.

Registration for Extended Day, Enrichment Classes, Private Music Lessons & Athletics:

- Deadline for enrolling students for Extended Day, enrichment classes & private music lessons is **Friday, August 29.**
- All outstanding invoices must be paid in full before the student may register for any Before or After-School Programs.
- All students must have a completed registration form on file accompanied by full payment in the office before participation in Extended Day, enrichment classes, private music lessons or athletics.
- Enrichment classes, private music lessons & athletics are filled on a “first come, first served basis.” It is advisable to register as soon as possible to avoid disappointment.
- Payment can be made via check (payable to The Rhoades School) or credit card (fee applies).

- Classes that do not meet the minimum enrollment requirement will be cancelled and participants will be notified as soon as possible.
- Enrichment classes are not prorated for late registration.
- **All fees are nonrefundable.**
- Athletics & Enrichment classes do not meet during school closure days or half-days.
- There is no provision for make-up classes if a participant is absent for any reason or if the school is closed due to an emergency.
- Parents must notify the music instructor within 24 hours if a student will miss a lesson. **If the instructor is not notified within 24 hours, instructors are not required to make up the missed lesson.**
- Parents are responsible for scheduling a music make-up lesson if a field trip/event conflicts with the music lesson within 24 hours of the anticipated lesson conflict.

Extended Day

Our program allows families the flexibility to drop-off before the school day starts and pick-up after the normal dismissal time. Our program is organized to support emotional, physical and cognitive wellness, provide your child with opportunities to learn valuable life skills, and to reinforce the skills they're learning during the school day.

Middle School students can remain on campus until 4:00 PM without incurring additional fees.



Students explore the exciting world of science, technology, engineering, art and math (STEAM) through building projects, experiments, and design challenges. Sharing ideas, asking questions, and making predictions are encouraged!



Robust outdoor free play and structured games help students learn sportsmanship and develop their physical strength and endurance. Students learn critical thinking and problem solving by participating in board games and team challenges with their peers.



Students express themselves by participating in hands-on visual arts. Students develop planning skills by working on long-term projects with their peers and can participate in group performances or discussions.



Social and emotional growth is nurtured through student and teacher led activities that promote a feeling of community and belonging. Students learn through open-ended activities that give them a chance to apply problem-solving skills and collaborate with friends.



Some students appreciate the chance for independent activities or study after a long day at school. We provide a quiet place to work on homework, read, journal, or seek academic support from peers and teachers. Students can also work on various projects in this small group setting.



Podcasting Club
