General Information

The Rhoades School offers both before and after-school care in our Extended Day and Athletics & Enrichment Programs. Students on campus after dismissal must be enrolled in Extended Day or other prescheduled activities such as athletics, enrichment classes or private music lessons.

Our Before & After School Programs offer students enriching opportunities for discovery and exploration before and after the normal school day hours. These programs provide numerous options for fun while also reinforcing the essential lessons and values taught throughout the school day.

Registration for Extended Day, Enrichment Classes, Private Music Lessons & Athletics:

- Deadline for enrolling students for Extended Day, enrichment classes & private music lessons is **Friday, August 28th.**
- All outstanding invoices must be paid in full before the student may register for any Before or After-School Programs.
- All students must have a completed registration form before participation in before and after care, enrichment classes, private music lessons or athletics.
- Enrichment classes, private music lessons & athletics are filled on a “first come, first served basis.” It is advisable to register as soon as possible to avoid disappointment.
- ACH payment can be made through the Alma portal.
- Classes that do not meet the minimum enrollment requirement will be cancelled and participants will be notified as soon as possible. A full refund will be issued.
- Enrichment classes are prorated for late registration.
- All fees are nonrefundable.
- Athletics, Before & After Care, and Enrichment classes do not meet during school closure days or half-days.
- There is no provision for make-up classes if a participant is absent for any reason or if the school is closed due to an emergency.
- Parents must notify the music instructor within 24 hours if a student will miss a lesson. If the instructor is not notified within 24 hours, instructors are not required to make up the missed lesson.
- Enrichment instructors will reschedule a session if canceled due to an unexpected circumstance.
- Parents are responsible for scheduling a music make-up lesson if a field trip/event conflicts with the music lesson within 24 hours of the anticipated lesson conflict.
- Please make note of the refund policy below:
 - By signing and submitting this registration form, you acknowledge that a space has been reserved in the class for your child and that staffing, materials, and program planning are based on this commitment.
